SUPPORTIVE POLICY ENVIRONMENT

Business & Regulatory Reforms

- 100% FDI permitted in Food Processing, Retail trading including e-commerce
- The National Single Window System hosts applications for approvals from 32 Central Departments and 29 State Governments / Union Territory Administrations
- Agro-Processing included in priority sector lending loans upto INR 100 crore (approx 12Mn) per borrower

Tax Reforms

- One of the lowest corporate tax globally at 15% for new businesses
- Remission of duties and taxes incurred on exports from India
- 100% exemption of Income Tax on profits and gains for new Food Processing Units for the initial five assessment years (Under Section 80IB (11A) of the Income Tax Act, 1961)
