




Key features & new Academic Initiatives

- 20% of International Faculty, 30-35 Distinguished Visiting Scholars from across the disciplines.
- Short-term courses that reflect the "Spirit of Nalanda"
- Constitution of Boards of School of Studies as part of mandated statutory framework.
- The University is planning to organize the second Convocation ceremony. First one was in 2016.
- Expansion of several scholarship schemes and introducing a number of new scholarships from this academic year i.e. 2025-26.
- Flexibility in Credit Structure with addition of courses of one or two credits and addition of courses on Yoga in lieu of seminar.
- Collaboration with the MANTRAMS Project, funded by a European Research Council (ERC) Synergy Grant to have a project which will work towards a global history and anthropology of mantra.
