



What is NRT Marriage Assistance Scheme?

Our scheme offers financial assistance to the children of Non-Resident Tamils who passed away. The initiative aims to provide marriage assistance with the goal of preventing them from accumulating debt due to unforeseen wedding expenses.

Am I eligible?

- You're eligible if you're the child of a Non-Resident Tamil who had an NRT ID card, provided their NRT ID card was valid when they passed away.
- You should currently be residing in India.
- The groom must have reached 21 years of age, and the bride must have reached 18 years of age at the time of marriage. Additionally, it supports only your first marriage.
- You are eligible if you have at least completed the 10th standard examination. For Schedule Tribes, completion of studies up to the 5th standard is sufficient for eligibility.
- The scheme is limited to two children per family.
